CIF TRANSACTION PROCEDURE

1 Buyer issues Irrevocable Corporate Purchase Order (ICPO), addressed to Seller's Refinery, along with Company Profile and Buyer's Passport.

2 Seller issues the Draft Sale & Purchase Agreement (SPA) for Buyer's review and signature.

3 Seller legalizes and registers the Contracts with Insurance Company and notarizes it with the appropriate authorities of the Ministry of Energy, along with the below PPOP documents:

- Product Passport Quality Certificate;
- Certificate of Product Origin;
- Product Availability;
- Commitment Letter to Supply
- Verbiage

4 Buyer verifies and proceed with the arrangements of issuing SBLC to Seller's nominated Bank, informing readiness to purchase. Buyer's Bank, in accordance with Seller's Verbiage, shall proceed to

issue SBLC within six (10) working days for the first shipment's value to Seller's Financial Bank, to enable Seller commence the loading of product with the Shipping Company. Seller finalizes loading within six (10) working days. But, if Buyer fails to issue SBLC within six (10) working days, as an alternative provision, Buyer pays (US\$ 356,000 USD) to Seller's nominated Russia insurance company within seven (7) days, which will be deducted from the Product's Invoice value of the Product, at Destination Port. 5 After confirmation by Seller's Bank, Seller at his own expense, charters with shipping/logistic company and alerts the Buyer on Shipping ordered Graphic/Schedule, accompanied with submission of nominated Vessel details to Buyer.

6 Seller's Bank responds with contractual operative 2% Performance Bond (PB) and full Proof of Product (POP) to Buyer's Bank within seventy-two (72) hours since Buyer's instrument confirmed by Seller's Bank:

- a) Copy of the Port Storage Agreement;
- b) Copy of the CPA, to transport the Product to Destination Port;
- c) Vessel's Q88;
- d) Original BL (Full Set); and,
- e) Copy of SGS Report.

7 Upon successful Product Confirmation, against SGS/CIQ Report of Quality & Quantity at Destination Port, Buyer makes payment by MT-103. 8 Seller and Buyer, within seventy-two (72) hours, Seller pays commissions to Seller's Side and Buyer pays to Buyer's Side Intermediaries involved in the Transaction.
